- 10% of clients pay \$120+ while 61% of clients pay less than \$40
- 34% of clients are below the poverty line for a family of four

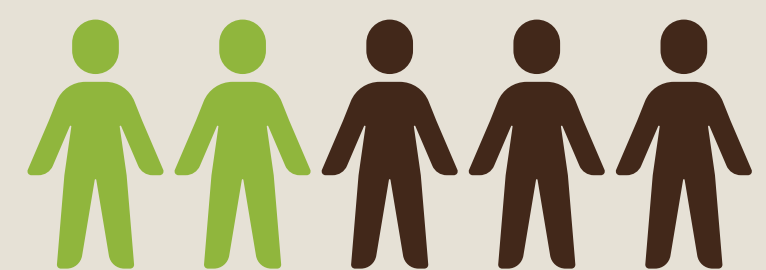
COMMON CONCERNS WE ADDRESS
